City Council Special Meeting Minutes Ordinances (Titles 1-8) March 17, 2008

Meeting started at 7:04 pm

 - **Title 1 Administration – Official City Code:** Title, Acceptance, Amendments, Code Alterations; Saving Clause: Repeal of General Ordinances, Public Ways and Public Utility Ordinances, Court Proceedings, Severability Clause; Definitions: Construction of Words, Definitions General, Catchlines; General Penalty: General Penalty, Application of Provisions, Liability of Officers; Mayor and City Council: Mayor, City Council, Compensation, Meetings, Adherence to Rules and Procedures, Rules; Officers and Employees: City Clerk, City Treasurer, Oath and Bond; Elections: Election of Mayor, Election of City Council, Hours of Polling Places for City Elections; Initiatives and Referendums: Creation of Right, Number of Petitioners Required, Form of Petition, Time for Filing Petitions for Referendums, Printing Petitions and Signature Sheets (Time Limit for Filing), Verification of Signature Sheets, Examination and Certification of Signatures, Removal of Signatures, Sufficiency of Petition (Notification, Election), Form of Ballot, Conduct of Election, Canvass of Returns, Prohibited Acts (Penalties).

- **Title 3 Public Health and Safety – Nuisances**: Definition of Nuisance, Duty of Maintenance of Private Property, Prohibited, Abatement of Nuisance by Owners, Penalty, Abatement by City; Fire Prevention: to be added; Fireworks: Fireworks, Dangerous Fireworks, Safe and Sane Fireworks, Fireworks Permit for Public Display, Permit for Sale or Safe and Sane Fireworks, Permit Regulations, Dates for Permit, Permit to Sell Safe and Sane Fireworks Application, Fireworks Permit for Public Display, Fireworks Permit for Public Display Application, Revocation of Permit, Penalty, Repealer, Effective.
 - **Title 4 Police Regulation – Animal Control**: Definition, License Required, License Fee, Tags to be Placed on Collar, Commercial and Non-Commercial Kennel License, Unlawful for Dogs to Run at Large, Unlawful to Interfere with Seizure or Killing Dogs, Cruelty Prohibited, Penalty, Repealing Ordinance, Effective Date of Ordinance; Criminal Code: Idaho Criminal Code, Adoption of Code, Code Copy, Provisions.
 - **Title 5 Motor Vehicles and Traffic – Parking**: Parking, Pedestrian Lane and Sidewalk, Dead Storage, Penalty; Motor Vehicle Laws: Intent, Adoption of Laws, Copy of Laws, Repealer; Engine Brakes: Unlawful use of Engine Brakes and Compression Brakes, Severability, Fine.
 - **Title 6 Public Ways and Public Property** – Reserved
 - **Title 7 Public Services** – still in progress
 - **Title 8 Building Regulations – Building Code**: Code Adoption, Amendments to Adopted Codes, Exemptions, Severability, Repeal of Conflicting Provisions; Energy Code and Conversion Standards: will be removed by resolution.
- Gallup asks Councilmen to review all the Ordinances (Titles 1-8) for a week. Let her know of any changes and she will present Final review at next City Council meeting.
