Note: An agenda may be amended, provided that a good faith effort is made to include, in the original agenda notice, all items known to be probable items of discussion. The agenda may be amended after the start of a meeting at the beginning of the meeting upon a motion that states the reason for the amendment and states the good faith reason the agenda item was not included in the original agenda posting (Idaho Code 67-2343).
